- 1. Students taking a TACT Program class are expected to agree with the following core Christian beliefs:
 - a. The divine inspiration and consequent authority of the whole canonical Scripture
 - b. The doctrine of the Trinity
 - c. The fall of man, his consequent moral depravity, and his need for regeneration
 - d. The virgin birth of Christ, atonement through His substitutionary death, His bodily resurrection and ascension into Heaven
 - e. The doctrine of justification by faith
 - f. The resurrection of the body, both of the just and the unjust
 - g. The eternal life of the saved and the eternal punishment of the lost
- 2. Our admissions policies are guided by the policies of partnering institutions.
- 3. Our moral and academic conduct policies are guided by the policies of partnering institutions. Students will be subject to the policies of the institution through which they register while enrolled in a TACT Program class.
- 4. In addition to the policies of the students' institutions, during the week when students are attending class the following conduct is expected:
 - a. No use of tobacco in any form
 - b. No use of pornography in any form
 - c. No use of alcoholic beverages
 - d. Courteous and respectful treatment of faculty, TACT personnel, hosts, cultural immersion presenters, and other students
 - e. Modest dress (casual is fine)
